# Campfire/Open Fire Burning Permit

Conditions required for validating permit:

- a) Are you the owner of the property?  Yes  No If no, written permission is needed from the owner.
- b) No fire, except in a proper furnace, stove or combustion apparatus shall be left to burn at any time without a person of at least nineteen (19) year of age in attendance.  
All ashes or other residue, the ground, walls, vegetation, etc. surrounding the site of the fire for (10) feet shall be thoroughly wetted and all embers quenched by wetting or adequately covered with earth before such ashes, residue or site is left unattended.
- c) The following material must not be burned:
 

Tire	Treated lumber
Plastics	Railway Ties
Drywall	Manure
Demolition Waste	Rubber
Domestic Waste	Asphalt
Paint	Asphalt Products
Hazardous Waste	Fuel & Lubricant Containers
Tar paper	Biomedical Waste

*And any other material not listed that may cause Air Quality Concerns.*
- d) Open grass burning is not permitted with the exception of fires started and maintained by the McBride Volunteer Fire Department.
- e) Size of burn pile cannot exceed - 8 cubic feet (2x2x2 feet)
- f) BURNING MUST NOT BE INITIATED IF THE LOCAL AIR FLOW WILL CAUSE THE SMOKE TO NEGATIVELY IMPACT ON A NEARBY POPULATION.
- g) There will be no burning in receptacles (for example: burning barrel).
- h) The Applicant wishes to have campfires on the above listed property:  Yes  No Campfire Permits (except where cancelled) are valid until October 31 of the current year.
- i) Open Fire Burning Permits are valid for 10 days from the date of application. Period during which this permit is valid: \_\_\_\_\_

As the applicant I agree to carry out any fire authorized by this permit in accordance with all relevant enactments, including the Fire Services Act of British Columbia and Regulations, the Forest Act of British Columbia and Regulations and the Waste Management Act of British Columbia and Regulations and the Wildfire Act of British Columbia and regulations and to release and indemnify and save harmless the Village of McBride from any and all claims and liability which I or any other person may have against the Village of McBride from the Fire authorized by this permit.
