The Village of McBride is excited to announce the launch of the FoodCycler Pilot Program!

This pilot program will offer up to 40 residents and non-residents the opportunity to obtain a FoodCycler at a reduced cost while helping the Village evaluate the program's success.

The 12-week pilot will start by May 1, 2026. Participants will be asked to use their FoodCycler regularly during the pilot period and provide feedback on their experience, along with data on household food waste reduction.

What is a FoodCycler™?

The FoodCycler™ is an in home food waste recycler that transforms food scraps into a nutrient-rich soil amendment with many beneficial uses, such as in your garden!

How it Works

- 1 ADD SCRAPS TO BUCKET
- 2 ADD BUCKET TO FOODCYCLER
- 3 PRESS START.

Why Should I Participate?

Did you know that food waste makes up the majority of household waste, and when put in the landfill it is a major contributor to greenhouse gas emissions?

By participating in the FoodCycler™ Pilot Program, you can keep food waste out of the landfill - reducing your carbon footprint and supporting the Town of Maple Creek's sustainability goals.

How It Works

The FoodCycler is a small appliance that dehydrates and grinds food waste, reducing its volume by up to 90% within hours.

The FoodCycler eliminates odors and makes it easy to divert food waste from the landfill, reducing greenhouse gas emissions and extending the life of our waste.
